KARIN VERES

Soprano, Senior Advisor, former Managing and Artistic Director, Assistant Artistic Director WSIMC (Sweden)

After completing her academic studies and receiving a Bachelor's degree in musicology, Karin studied voice at the Academy of Music and Drama, University of Gothenburg. She was singing at the Göteborg Opera, Sweden, from 1982–2004.

After teaching and managerial responsibilities at the Academy of Music and Drama, University of Gothenburg, as well as working with the Swedish Arts Council, Karin left the stage to concentrate on her administrative and artistic career. She was Choir Manager at the Gothenburg Opera and from 2007 General Director of the Borås City Theatre. 2011-2017 Karin Veres held the position of Managing and Artistic Director of the Norrköping Symphony Orchestra, which with its 85 musicians, celebrated their centenary year in 2012. The orchestra plays a central role in the region's cultural life and has, through international tours and extensive recordings, received international acclaim. World famous conductors and soloists perform together with the Norrköping Symphony Orchestra both in Sweden and on international tours.

Karin is currently Chairman of the Board of The City Theatre in Gothenburg.

MEMBERS OF THE JURY:



NADER ABBASSI
Artistic Director/Principal Conductor, The Cairo
Opera Orchestra (Egypt/Switzerland)

In his conducting career, Nader Abbassi take advantage of his exceptionally wide and professional experience as a singer, bassoonist and composer.

In July 2011 Nader Abbassi was appointed Artistic and Musical Director of Katara Culture Foundation in Qatar. Between 2009 to 2011, he was the first Musical Director & Principal Conductor for the newly formed Qatar Philharmonic Orchestra. He was the Artistic Director and Principal Conductor of the Cairo Opera Orchestra 2002–2011.

In 2002 Nader Abbassi made his acclaimed debut conducting "Aida" at the pyramids in Giza.

Nader Abbassi is also the Artistic Director of the Orchestre pour la Paix in Paris.

Abbassi is a permanent member, as well as the conductor, of the The Wilhelm Stenhammar International Music Competition in Norrköping.

In 2006 Nader Abbassi conducted Menotti's opera "Maria Golovine" in the presence of the composer at the MarseilleOpera House. Since then he regularly returned to conduct concerts and operas and for opera productions at Opéra de Bordeaux and at The Glimmerglass Festival New York USA.

Nader Abbassi conducts many international orchestras – Symphony Orchestras in Basel, Heidelberg, München, Marseille, Bordeaux, Lisboa, Genève, and many others. He gave his US debut with the Sacramento Philharmonic Orchestra in spring 2008.

The compositions of Nader Abbassi are performed by many orchestras.

Nader Abbassi was awarded the Citation of Excellence and Outstanding Music Award in USA. He has also won several first prizes from the Egyptian Ministry of Culture for bassoon and composition. He was the winner of the Mozart Chamber Music Competition in Geneva, 1992.



GEORGES DELNONArtistic Director (Switzerland)

Georges Delnon is a Swiss director, theatre director and professor. Raised in Berne, he studied history and art history at the Universities of Berne and Fribourg as well as composition and music history at the Berne Conservatory. In 1985 he was one of the founders of "Atelier 20" a group for contemporary theatre and music in Berne.

In addition, Georges Delnon holds teaching posts at numerous universities and academies. In 2003 he was appointed honorary professor at the Johannes Gutenberg University in Mainz.

In 1996 he took over his first post as artistic director at the Municipal Theatre in Koblenz and was co-founder of the festival Festungsspiele Koblenz.

From 1999 to 2006 he was artistic director of the Mainz State Theatre. In 2005 and 2006 he staged the world premiere of Zaubern by Fredrik Zeller and the baroque opera Prosperina by Joseph Martin Kraus at the Schwetzingen Festival.

With the beginning of the 2006/2007 season, Georges Delnon was appointed director of the Basel Theatre, the largest three-genre theatre in Switzerland.

From 2009 to 2016 Georges Delnon has been artistic director of musical theatre for the Schwetzingen SWR Festival. The two world premieres "Prosperina" in 2009 and "Koma" in 2016, had been awarded "world premiere of the year" in the critic survey of "Opernwelt".

With the beginning of the 2015/2016 season, he took up his position as artistic director of the Hamburg State Opera.



GÖRAN GADEMAN

Dramaturgist/Casting Coordinator (Sweden)

Göran Gademan is a dramaturgist and casting coordinator at the Gothenburg Opera since 2006. Before that he was employed at the Department of Theater Studies at the University of Stockholm. He made his PhD there 1996 with the dissertation The Realism at the Opera (RealismenpåOperan), and his book Gay Opera Lovers (Operabögar) was edited in 2004. He has also contributed with the opera parts in the work New Swedish Theatre History (2007), and the same year he got the title senior lecturer. In fall 2015 he released an international opera history, Operahistoria, the first one in Swedish in fifty years. At the Opera Conservatory in Gothenburg he is a lecturer in opera history since 2017, and also a coach in audition

In 2019, Göran became a three-time, and thus eternal, grand champion in SVT's "Kulturfrågan Kontrapunkt", with his team Witt-Brattström. He came in fifth place over this year's music personalities on the Magazine OPUS list. In 2021, Göran published the book "Wagner as a dramaturge" once again at Gidlund's publishing house. In 2022, Göran received King Carl XVI Gustaf's medal, the eight size, in high blue ribbon, for "outstanding contributions in Swedish opera art".



FRANZISKA MARIA KAISER
Casting Consultant (Germany)

Franziska Maria Kaiser is a freelance Casting Consultant, based in Berlin.

Her educational background consists of a voice- and vocal pedagogy diploma from Hochschule der Künste Bern (2004/05), as well of a Master's degree in Arts Management from University of Basel (2006). She worked in an artist's agency before joining the artistic administration at Opernhaus Zürich 2010-2014. From August 2014 till September 2021 Franziska M. Kaiser worked at the Royal Danish Opera in Copenhagen as Artistic Administrator and from 2017 also as Head of Casting. October 2021 to June 2022 Franziska works as Casting Consultant for the Royal Danish Opera. Alongside she will work with Opera Europa as Consultant for the further development of "Operabook", an online database and reference for Opera Europa members.

Franziska is part of the Jury of "Wilhelm Stenhammar International Music Competition" in Norrköping (Sweden), Jurymember of "Voci Verdiane" Busseto in in June 2022, as well as member of the Jury for "Jerusalem Voice Competition" and "CLIP Portofino" both in July 2022.

During spring 2022 Franziska attended leadership courses at University Zürich (EMAA) as well as playing an active part during a conference about "Theatre of the future, future of theatre" in Dortmund.



ERKI PEHK
Artistic Director/Conductor
Pärnu International Opera Music Festival
- PromFest, Klaudia Taev International
Competition for Young Opera Singers (Estonia)

Studied piano, choir conducting at the Estonian Academy of Music. He continued his studies in orchestra conducting in Riga at the Latvian Academy of Music and finalised his studies as a postgraduate student at the Guildhall School of Music and Drama in London.

For 17 years (1994–2011) Erki Pehk was engaged as a conductor at the Estonian National Opera in Tallinn conducting more than 700 opera, ballet, operetta and musical performances of this company. He also held a teaching position of conducting at the Tallinn Music College from 1992-1997.

He has built up his reputation as an orchestra and opera conductor performing throughout the Europe with musical theatres and orchestras in France, Germany, Finland, the Netherlands, Hungary, Belarus, Bulgaria, Russia, Ukraine, Latvia, Lithuania, and his homeland Estonia. Since 2001 Mr. Pehk is the Artistic Director of the renowned Klaudia Taev International Competition for Young Opera Singers in Pärnu (Estonia) and since 2005 the Artistic Director of the Pärnu International Opera Music Festival – Prom Fest.



PAOLO PINAMONTI Artistic Director (Italy)

Born in 1958, Paolo Pinamonti graduated in Philosophy at Venice University and Piano at National Conservatory of Padua. Since 1992 he has been researcher at the University Ca' Foscari in Venice where he is currently teaching History of Contemporary Music and History of Film Music.

From 1992 to 1996 he was Assistant of Artistic Director of International Festival of Contemporary Music of Venice Biennale.

In 1997 he began his career as Artistic Director in various Italian and European theatres.

From 1997 to 2000 was the Artistic Director of Theater La Fenice in Venice. During the 1999 season of La Fenice he was granted three awards «Abbiati» by the Music Critics National Association: one for the best Italian revelation (Aus Deutschland by Mauricio Kagel, under Herbert Wernicke); a second for the best-chosen staging (The Cunning Little Vixen by Janáček, under David Poutney); and a third award for the best initiative in the field of theatrical experimentation with the cycle «L'Altra scena».

From 2001 to 2007 he was General Manager and Artistic Director of São Carlos Theatre in Lisbon. From 2007 to 2010 he was Artistic Director of the lyric summer festival: «Mozart Festival» in La Coruña, and from 2011 to 2015 he was Artistic Director of the Zarzuela Theatre in Madrid. From 2015 to 2020 he was Artistic Director of the «Teatro di San Carlo» in Naples. He is currently Artistic Director in «Macerata Opera Festival».

Besides to his artistic job in the directions of the theatres, he has continued his scientific activity. Amidst his investigation activities, he has directed his research towards the following themes: aspects of the Venetian theatrical life of the XIX century, some topics in musical history of the XX century. He was also the author of a critical edition of the opera Sigismondo by Rossini, which was presented in the Rossini Opera Festival (2010).

In 2006 was appointed «Commander of the Infante D. Enrique Order» by the President of Portuguese Republic. In 2014 was appointed «Officer of Order of "Stella d'Italia» by the Presidente of Italian Republic. In 2015, the King of Spain gave him the «Encomenda con Placa» of the order of «Alfonso X el sabio»

ACCOMPANISTS



KIRILL KOSLOVSKI Belarus/Finland

Kirill Kozlovski is a Belarussian-born Finnish pianist. His piano teachers included Irina Semenyako, Matti Raekallio, Ilmo Ranta and Avo Kouyoumdjian. Kirill holds a doctorate degree from the Sibelius Academy for his research of the music of Dmitri Shostakovich (2017). His present research projects concentrate on Soviet piano music as well as performance practices within the Soviet piano school.

A laureate of both national and international piano competitions, Kirill Kozlovski has given solo recitals and been a member of chamber ensembles at international festivals in France, Germany, Switzerland, Russia, Estonia, Spain, Finland and Belarus. He has appeared as a soloist with orchestras in Finland and abroad, collaborating with conductors such as Andris Nelsons, Janos Fürst, Dima Slobodeniouk, John Storgårds and Klaus Mäkelä to name but a few. Kirill Kozlovski performs regularly with Finland's foremost singers including Jorma Hynninen, Monica Groop, Mika Kares, Tuomas Katajala and Miina-Liisa Värelä.





MAGNUS SVENSSON Sweden

Pianist, Magnus Svensson, is acknowledged as one of the leading Scandinavian accompanists, collaborating with singers worldwide including Pretty Yende, Dorothea Röschmann, Nina Stemme, Christophe Prégardien, Malin Byström, Benjamin Appl, Miah Persson, Irène Theorin, Katarina Karnéus, Anna Larsson, Ailish Tynan, Ann Hallenberg, John Lundgren, Matthew Rose, Elin Rombo, Camilla Tilling, Daniel Johansson, Kristina Hammarström, Cornelia Beskow, as well as rising stars such as Christina Nilsson and Johanna Wallroth.

Renowned for his versatility and extensive repertoire knowledge, he is a regular solo guest, chamber musician and accompanist at leading music venues and festivals across Scandinavia, Europe, and the United States. In the 2021-2022 season Magnus continues his strong relationship with the Konserthuset Stockholm, his musical home since 2015. A highly respected programmer, he curates the prestigious Lied series for the Konserthuset, which is now in its nineth season. Guests next season include Ian Bostridge, Bryn Terfel & Nina Stemme.

Magnus has a wide-ranging discography including solo piano discs of Mozart, Schumann and Bach. Adding to his fast-growing collection of Lied discs, upcoming releases include recordings with Irene Theorin and Malin Byström.

He has been the Musical Editor at The Royal Swedish Academy of Music since 2012 and has since published over 750 new editions of Swedish music. For many years he was involved in the extensive programming of music and concerts produced in association with the Royal Palace in Stockholm. He teaches at the Royal Academy of Music in Stockholm as well as at The College of Music and Opera at Mälardalens University.


